Hockey (Ages 6+)

Materials: 3 children's hockey sticks, a net (which can just be made using different objects, i.e. chairs to signify boundaries), a ball, small pylons

How to play:

- For our booth we'll only be playing a simple game of taking shots on the net with a goaltender
- To make the game more interesting different obstacles (pylons) will be placed throughout the play area and players must maneuver around them, similar to hockey drills
