Rings (Ages 3+)

Materials: Board with hooks and numbers above the hooks, rings of some sort

How to play:

- Players will throw rings at the board and try to get it onto the hook
- If more than one player is playing the player with most points (determined by numbers above the rings) wins

Historical Background:

Rings was played by families all over Britain and Ireland during the Victorian Era and today is still enjoyed by not only kids but adults all over the country.

Corners (Ages 4+)

Requires at least 5 people

How to play:

- One player will be in the middle while everybody else will stand in a corner (denoted by an 'X' on the ground)
- The person in the middle will randomly call 'change corners', at which point all other players will run to claim a new corner, including the person in the middle
- Whoever is left without a corner will now be the person in the middle

Gold Coin Toss (Ages 3+)

Materials: Fake coins, chocolate wrapped as coins, a golden pot

How to play:

- There will be one pot that will signify the 'Leprechaun's Pot of Gold', players must try to throw a coin into the pot
- The ground will be marked at different distances that the players can try to throw it from
- If players choose to throw it from a certain large distance they have a chance of throwing gold coin chocolates, if they get it in they get to keep the chocolate
